

Modified Option 2—Deer application deadline remains April

Features of this option include:

- Both online and paper applications will be accepted.
- With online application, resident applicants can purchase discount licenses (i.e. general hunting, general hunting and fishing, junior/senior/handicapped).
- Online applicants can select and purchase the Habitat Stamp, Habitat Management & Access Validation and HIP Card number when applying.
- Online applicants will receive an ‘Authorization Number’ that identifies the license type and validations purchased. This ‘Authorization Number’ will serve as a license and be valid beginning April 1 (or time of purchase if after April 1) through the entire license year.
- Successful applicants will receive the purchased license with a carcass tag.
- Permits will no longer be issued for deer. Deer hunters will only be required to have a deer license in their possession.
- Unsuccessful online applicants will receive a refund equal to the difference between the submitted fees and the price of any remaining desired discount license and validation fees, if purchased.
- If a paper application is used, only a deer license will be issued to successful applicants.
- For unsuccessful applicants, private land-only deer licenses may be purchased from any license vendor.
